

Portion of Letter from Lord Kingston to John Henderson dated
22.6.22

My best day was 4 fish, 6 $\frac{1}{2}$, 5 $\frac{1}{4}$, 4 $\frac{3}{4}$, 4 $\frac{1}{4}$, next best 5 $\frac{3}{4}$, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$, 3 $\frac{1}{4}$, those were the only two days I really had any luck. I got none over 7 and I don't think I saw any, 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ was my best fish. I heard from McLeod at the bank, Boyle he bought two 10 £ 10 $\frac{1}{2}$, supposed to be caught in Andersna bay on the Murrough but as I don't think there are any Murrough there it must have been a net. But at present one is quite powerless to do anything. Do you think it is worth my while to send away those cutters (lathe) to be sharpened? I have no heart to spend any money on anything till we see if one will be allowed to live in this country. I am spinning on [indistinguishable] at the present moment, was going to [indistinguishable] but Ethel won't be back till about July 11th so that's off. Hoping your fit and well, forgive the long scrawl.
